How to find the venue


By car

- Autobahn A 565 to exit "Poppelsdorf"
- turn right at first traffic light into "Jagdweg"
- follow signs to "Kliniken Venusberg"
- on top of hill "Venusberg" turn first street left into "Abbestraße" to find the Eye Hospital main entrance

By bus from Bonn main station

- take bus line 620, 621 or 626 from Bonn main station and exit at stop "Casselsruhe"
- walk down the main street "Robert-Koch-Straße"
- follow signs to "Augenklinik" left into "Abbestraße" to find the Eye Hospital main entrance
